British Synchronised Skating Championships Posted: 30-01-06

Isle Of Wight synchronised skating team the Wight Diamonds competed in their first ever British championships on 22 January. The team competed in the intermediate section of the championships, which were held in Nottingham.

The 15 skaters who make up the Wight Diamonds have been skating together as a team for less than two months, and formed the youngest team by far.

Every member of the team skated fantastically. With the most-improved marks out of all of the teams in the category, the Wight Diamonds finished in a credible 5th place, ahead of a team from Gosport that had beaten them in the qualifying heat in November 2005.

The top teams have many more years' experience and are older, so the future looks bright for the Wight Diamonds as a very young novice team that is improving quickly.

Coached by Terri Fleming, the team consists of Sarah England, Phoena Wilmott Bayer, Kate Nutborne, Emme Wilks, Georgina Bourne, Katie Brannan, Emily Adams, Kate England, Gemma Marsh, Nicole Hinton, Ellie Taylor, Yelena Brown, Sabrina Danzig, Sarah Close, Gemma Fishel and Isabelle Coeshott. [Top]

She is now qualified to enter the British Primary championships in December. Sophie, who is coached by Anita Curtis, passed both elements of the Primary test at the first attempt. [Top]

Southern League, Streatham heat

The Streatham heat of the Southern League was held on 12 June. Please note that the following results are subject to confirmation and are based on analysis of the results from Skate Score.

Provisional positions and points at Streatham are as follows: **1** Streatham, 23 points; **2** Guildford, 23 points; **3**= IOW, 20 points; **3**= Gosport, 20 points; **5** Alexandra Palace, 17 points.

This would put the overall positions as: **1** Streatham, 46 points; **2** Guildford, 44 points; **3**= IOW, 39 points; **3**= Gosport, 39 points; **5** Alexandra Palace, 37 points. The next heat is in Gosport on 10 July.

Positions of IOW skaters were as follows: Class 1: **4th** Yelena Brown; Class 2: **2nd** Sabrina Danzig; Class 3: **2nd** Archie Bicknell; Class 4: **5th** Isabelle Coeshott; Class 6, **1st** Gemma Marsh; and Class 7, **2nd** Matthew Kershaw. There were no Island entries for Classes 5 and 8.

The Isle of Wight heat of the Southern League was held at Planet Ice, Ryde, on 29 May. The results were close, with only four points separating the teams.

The teams' positions going into the Streatham heat on 12 June are: **1** Streatham, 23 points; **2** Guildford, 21 points; **3** Alexandra Palace, 20 points; **4**= IOW, 19 points; **4**= Gosport, 19 points.

Gemma Marsh was third in the free skating event for level 5 girls aged 11 and under. Skating with Rachel Jackson of Basingtoke, she picked up another third in the artistic groups. Isabelle Coeshott, Gemma Fishel and Emma Wilks took second in the same event, pipping Rachel and Gemma by just 0.2 points.

Matthew Kershaw was first in the novice men's group, having to skate to standard. Wightlink-sponsored Matt and partner Laura Webb of Basingstoke were first in the novice pairs. [Top]
